Profile: Midtown student Tames Laseter - Hall



rist impressions mean a lot to James Laseter-Hall, a standout 14-year-old freshman at De La Salle Institute on Chicago's south side. At a very young age and a time of life when countless students and their families seek guidance, James first learned about Midtown. He was indeed impressed.

"Representatives from Midtown came to visit my elementary school when I was in third grade. I was immediately impressed with what they had to offer to help students like me, both from an academic and character development standpoint.

"After that first visit, I knew I wanted to be a part of Midtown and signed up right away. Since then, I'm happy to represent the center in all aspects of my life."

James has already represented Midtown at the highest level by earning two of MEF's most prestigious

scholarships: the Dan Jorndt Leadership Award and the Daniel Murphy Scholarship.

Among the many factors that makes Midtown a unique experience for students looking for direction, James states a critical reason why Midtown is so special to him.

"I've attended schools throughout my life that have both boys and girls attending. It was important to me that I was surrounded by an all-male staff and advisors who truly understood my experiences as a young man. The male presence at Midtown has helped me so much, especially being an adolescent and an African-American male."

Citing the three words on how others would describe him ("determined, dedicated, independent"), James is intentional about making an impact in whatever career path he chooses. He is grateful for the career guidance being provided to him at Midtown.

"I haven't decided what I want to do just yet.
I've been in several career-focused programs at
Midtown that have been of great interest, so we'll
see. However, I really enjoy and take pride in being
an orator, as I have spoken publicly for a number
of community organizations, including Operation
PUSH.

"The Midtown staff, especially (Midtown Achievement Program Director) Carlos Martinez, continue to help me narrow down my decisions on what I want to do in my life.

It's a great feeling to know you are being supported 24/7."



Profile: Metro alumna Gisselle Contreras



Persistent, analytical, compassionate.

Those are the words Metro alumna, DePaul University junior and proud first-generation Latina college student Gisselle Contreras states how others would describe her.

Gisselle is majoring in "Integrated Neuroscience Concentration" (pre-med) at the acclaimed Chicagobased university. She has her sights set on becoming a doctor. Her path leading up to college, however, met with some tough challenges.

"In seventh grade, I experienced the hard reality of bullying and I totally lost my confidence. Middle school can be such a difficult stage for any student and I was miserable. However, one day my mom showed me a pamphlet for the Metro summer program. It caught my attention right away because it looked interesting and fun, so we took a tour of the Metro Achievement Center. "After meeting the staff, everyone was just so welcoming and I quickly felt right at home. The kindness and warmth they provided made me feel amazing and all my fears of not fitting in disappeared immediately. It was clear I was important to them, which meant so much to me."

Gisselle continued her Metro journey from that point in seventh grade all the way through high school. In her junior year she took the center's "College Seminar" class, which helped her navigate the oftencomplicated college application process.

"As a first-generation college student and being the oldest child in my family, going to college seemed like an impossible dream."

Metro also helped Gisselle decide on a career. As for why she wants to become a doctor, her priorities are clear. "I'll have the opportunity to help individuals of all ages not only from a physical healthcare standpoint, but mentally and emotionally as well. In addition, there needs to be more representation from the Latino community in the medical field today."

Gisselle continues to be a part of the Metro family to this day, working part-time at the Center. When asked what advice she would give to prospective Metro students, she again cites her personal experience.

"Going to Metro will give you the opportunity to be yourself and will give you the confidence to recognize your abilities both academically and as a person. Self-worth is everything and I'm grateful to Metro for giving me that lifelong gift."



A Summary of **MEF Programs**

Walgreens One-on-One Program (4th to 6th grade)

Exceptional individuals serve as volunteer tutors/mentors for students. In weekly sessions, they help students with homework, present them with positive role models, and develop in them the study habits associated with high achievers.

Midtown/Metro Achievement Program (7th & 8th grade)

Math, science and English courses prepare students to enter college preparatory high schools and ultimately, college. Character development helps students begin to form a decision framework and vision for their future.

College Orientation Program (9th to 12th grade)

College, career and social readiness are emphasized in this program, which offers help with college entrance exams, rigorous academics, enriching character classes, and help with college and scholarship applications. Students also engage in extracurricular offerings such as apprenticeships, community service projects and cultural and college field trips.

The Parenting Program

Seminars, support groups and individual counseling support parents in their important role as the primary educators of their own children.




